ShareLink Instructions:

ShareLink is a device that allows you to wirelessly display your laptop. ShareLink is device agnostic, so it can be used with almost any device (Windows laptop, Apple laptop, iPad, tablets, iPhones, Android phones, etc.). You can connect by downloading the ShareLink application or using Airplay if you have an Apple device. Both professors and students can connect wirelessly.

Laptop Instructions

1st time:

- 1. Type the IP Address displayed on the ShareLink splash screen into a web browser.
- 2. Press the "Install Pro Software for ..." for your operating system.
 - a. This application can be used with any ShareLink on campus.
- 3. Finish the download process.

Every time after:

- 1. Make sure you are connected to Sacramento State's Eduroam WiFi.
- 2. Press the ShareLink button on the touch/control panel.
- 3. Open the ShareLink application.
- 4. Wait for the "Choose a Receiver" menu to pop up and click "Manual"
- 5. Type in the IP Address and code displayed on the ShareLink splash screen.
- 6. Press the play button.
- 7. To stop sharing your screen, press the stop button.

Tablet/Phone Instructions

1st time:

1. Download the "MirrorOp for Extron ShareLink" or "MirrorOp Sender for Galaxy" application.

Every time after:

- 1. Make sure you are connected to Sacramento State's Eduroam WiFi.
- 2. Press the ShareLink button on the touch/control panel.
- 3. Open the "MirrorOp for Extron ShareLink" or "MirrorOp Sender for Galaxy" application.
- 4. Press the button in the top right corner.
- 5. Press "Manual Input".
- 6. Type in the IP Address displayed on the ShareLink splash screen.
- 7. Type in the code displayed on the ShareLink splash screen.
- 8. Navigate to what you would like to display.
- 9. Press play on the top bar.
- 10. To stop sharing your screen, press the pause button on the top bar.
